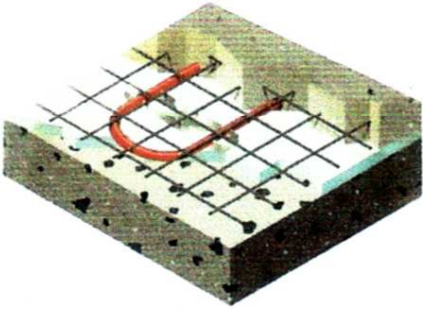

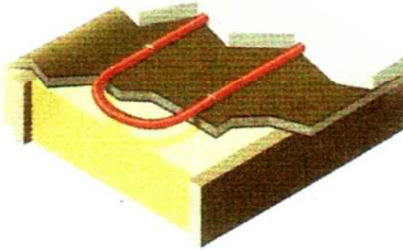
## FROM HARDWOOD TO TILE, WE'VE GOT IT COVERED

REHAU's radiant heating system is compatible with a variety of floor coverings, including hardwood, carpet, vinyl, ceramic tile and marble.

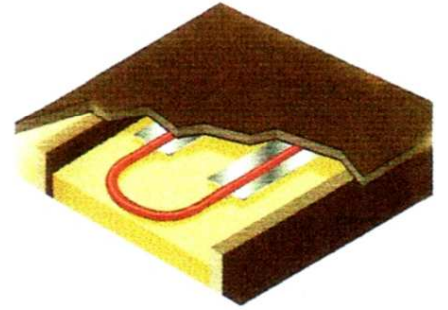
It's important to let your contractor know what type of floor covering you plan on installing so that you can achieve the maximum benefit from your radiant system.



*Pipes can be installed in a normal concrete slab, either on or below grade, usually with no design changes to the slab.*



*Pipes can also be installed above suspended wood floors and encased in a thin slab overpour, usually 1.5" (38 mm) thick.*



*In some structures, it is more convenient to install pipes in the joist space under a suspended wood floor.*
